Improvements to tenancy services

- * nationwide launch of a new FastTrack Resolution service, that will help landlords and tenants to resolve rent arrears disputes in a faster and more efficient way. Under this new service, a process that could previously take up to 12 days can now be completed in as little as 48 hours.
- * The Government also launched a new online system for Tenancy Tribunal applications, which will reduce processing times significantly.
- * The next priority for the Government will be in upgrading the tenancy bond system to an online service.

Housing warrant of fitness Challenges and Opportunities

- * The Government has been trialling a **housing minimum quality standard** on state houses
- * The Government is open minded around minimum quality standards for rental properties but we have always been clear that the benefits of **any housing** warrant of fitness scheme must be balanced with issues of cost and supply.
- * We also do not want to remove houses from the market unnecessarily in the middle of a housing shortage. For instance, a proposed warrant of fitness may stipulate that a property must be insulated.
- * On the mandatory installation of fire alarms: We need to ensure the responsibilities around improving fire protection falls fairly between the landlord and the tenant.
